Purchasing Card.

All groups receive a shopping card after arrival at the Vendelbo Jamboree.

The amount available is the group's amount for food, an amount consisting of 60 kr. per. day per. scout, minus costs for the hike for junior, troop and explorer.

Vendelbo Division has for many years had a very good cooperation with Mosbjerg Brugs (Super market), it also applies this time. The Group's amount to food is deposited in Mosbjerg Brugs and is raised by every purchase on the group's account. Every day Brugsen has purchased "today's meat" (e.g. minced beef, chicken, etc.). There will always be enough of this meat for all, but the group themselves choose what to buy. In this manner, the group themselves decides the menu at the camp, and must not take care of cash.

The group is committed to store the receipts, and is thus responsible for knowing the account balance. The card must be returned before leaving the camp and possible excess are deposited in the group account after the camp.

There can only be purchased on the account in the supermarket when the card is brought and presented at the purchase.

There can of course always be traded for cash and with credit card. It is also possible to pay with Euro.

Fruit stand

We have prioritized that it should be easy to eat fruit. Therefore there will be a fruit stand at the camp, with free fruit. In this way fruit is made easy and accessible.

Candy stand.

Of course there is also a candy stand at the camp, with candy, soda, chips and ice cream. We encourage Scouts to use the stand, rather than to cross the road to the supermarket. In order both to keep the scouts in the camp, but also to make room in the supermarket for the groups larger food shopping.



Overview of "Today's meat" in the supermarket:

Saturday July 25: Neck chops or plate chops (Pork)

Sunday July 26: Minced beef

Monday July 27: Chicken and turkey (thigh, upper thigh and filet)

Tuesday July 28: Cowboy day, se below

Wednesday July 29: Grill (sausages spare ribs, etc.) or Sausage Dish.

Thursday July 30: Minced Pork

Friday July 31: Diced meat (pork and chicken)

Saturday August 1: Departure
